The second annual Boiling Springs Tea Party was held this evening starting at 5:00 PM. The Boiling Springs Tea Party has been one of the largest and the most active Tea Parties in South Carolina. Hundreds of enthusiastic Tea Partiers assembled this evening to tell our elected officials that they have been **Taxed Enough Already!**

The highlight of the evening was an address by Dr. Christina Jeffrey who has been endorsed in her bid for congress by the Boiling Springs Tea Party. "But today" Dr Jeffrey said, is "all about taxes!"

Tea Parties all across the upstate agree with Christina Jeffrey. She has been endorsed by the Boiling Springs Tea Party as their clear choice in the 4th Congressional District. This past Monday evening Christina Jeffrey also won the Straw Poll the Greenville Tea Party conducted at their regular monthly meeting. Jeffrey garnered the support of 56% of the Straw Poll voters. Spartanburg Solicitor Trey Gowdy was a distant second place with just under 23% of the vote and the remaining 20% was split three ways between incumbent Bob Inglis, State Senator Dave Thomas, and retired Air Force Reserve Sgt. Jim Lee.

Christina Jeffrey holds a Ph.D. in Political Science from the University of Alabama, is a Blue Star mother with five children, eight grandchildren, and she is married to Dr. Robert Jeffrey.
